SYNOPSIS

A portrait of the turbulent life of the now 80-year-old director, cinematographer and film pioneer N. Paul Kenworthy Jr. Among his many accomplishments, Paul Kenworthy conceived and filmed the OSCAR awardwinning classic Disney film The Living Desert in 1953. In 1977, he was recognized by the Academy in Los Angeles for the unprecedented development and implementation of the Snorkel Camera – an innovation still in use today, 50 years later.
