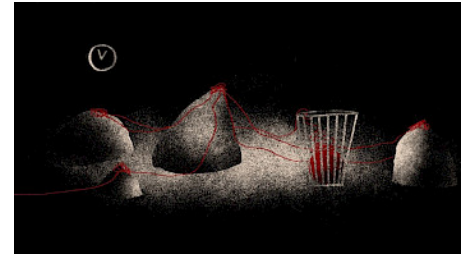


CARLOTTA'S FACE
