



DANGER ZONES & OTHER HAMBURGENSIEN

SYNOPSIS

At the end of 2013, three major conflicts overlapped in Hamburg: the fight for the autonomous cultural centre Rote Flora, the disputes about the right to remain of the refugees from Lampedusa and the protests against the demolition of the ES-SO tower blocks. Just before Christmas, the police used violence to break up a demonstration and the situation escalated. The police then set up so-called 'danger zones', activists from the area of St. Pauli, which had been particularly affected by this development, made toilet brushes their symbol of protest and organized a pillow fight on the Reeperbahn. Gefahrengebiete & andere Hamburgensien is the essay-like chronicle of a 'hot winter', the after-effects of which are still felt in the city today.
