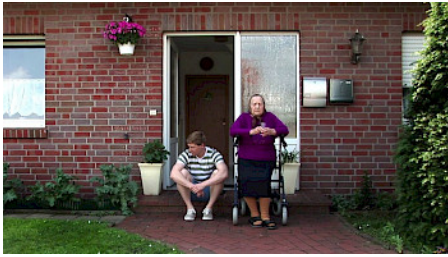


# FAMILY LIFE
