## SYNOPSIS

An environmental documentary that journeys to Greenland - the world's largest island, suspended between the Arctic and Atlantic oceans. In southern Greenland, where ice is melting faster than almost anywhere on Earth, the film pairs breathtaking landscapes with urgent climate science. It follows a renowned glaciologist who has studied Greenland's ice loss for three decades and now works to support reforestation efforts for a more sustainable future.
