SYNOPSIS

The documentary film "JEWISH TRANSIT BERLIN - From Hell to Hope" uncovers the post-war fate of the Jewish women, men and children who survived the Shoah in the Soviet Union, Poland and Eastern Europe and sought refuge in the Displaced Persons camps in Berlin. The film preserves the memory of the last remaining eyewitnesses and enriches their testimonials with never seen motion picture footage showing Berlin 1945 and the life inside the large Jewish DP camps of Schlachtensee and Tempelhof. While most documentaries recall the Shoah "JEWISH TRANSIT BERLIN - From Hell to Hope" intends to shed new light on the "day after".
