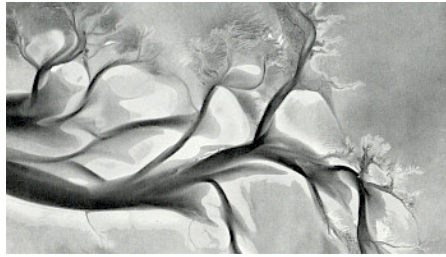




LANDEN

SYNOPSIS
