SYNOPSIS

Nonna lives alone in southern Italy, maintaining a house that she and her husband built after more than three decades of guest work in Germany. Since her husband died, she has been running a two-storey bed and breakfast on her own, which has seen better days. Her daily routines are marked by hardship and disappointment: the hard work doesn't get any easier with age. Her children and grandchildren remain in Germany.
