## SYNOPSIS

Axel, Tino and Jan live their dream of sex, drugs and rock & roll since fifteen years ago, working as stagehands for bands and festivals. Now they approach forty, their bodies do not work as they did once, the tension between the punk rock attitude and the desire to settle down grows.
