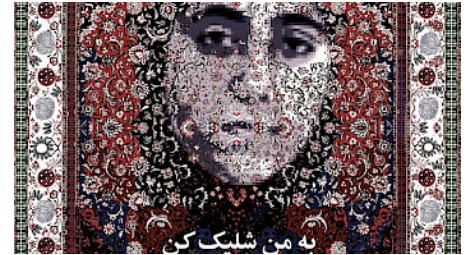




SHOOT ME
