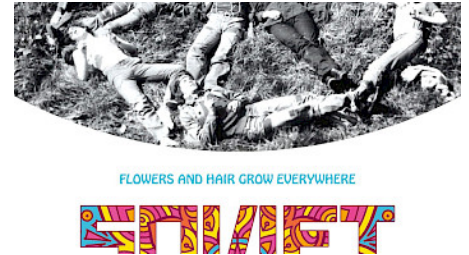




SOVIET HIPPIES

SYNOPSIS
