with her camera. She went with her to in search of traces of her memories,

accompanied her to operations and experienced Etchika in many

exceptional situations. She documents insights into a dramatic life.

The viewer experiences a traumatized youth who grew up in the GDR and

struggles for 62 years to find his identity. Olaf goes through hopes and aberrations,

becomes a rich businessman in West Berlin and finally a successful boxing promoter.

But every stage of Etchika's life is associated with inner conflicts, suffering and a

rollercoaster of emotions. The daily look in the mirror becomes the compass of her life.

Etchika talks openly in the documentary:

About drug use, hopelessness, sex in the wrong body, travesty and a longing for death.
